

# **Application for Research Experience: Cleveland Clinic Foundation Lerner Research Institute**

Investigators at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation's Lerner Research Institute (LRI) may consider taking talented Honors and Scholars students into their laboratories for unpaid research experiences during the Spring Semester.

## **Student Benefits and Expectations:**

Students will earn 8 hours of CSU course credit for the experience. Students are expected to work at least 16 hours per week at LRI and, at the same time, maintain certain course work as required for their degree. The student, with the assistance of the Honors/Scholars major faculty advisor, will negotiate with their department how the credits earned through the experience will apply to their degree requirements.

## **Application Process:**

- ✓ Students wanting to be considered for the LRI Research Experience must prepare a packet of information and answer the questions on the cover sheet.
  - Applicants will need to identify a CSU faculty member willing to serve as their supervisor prior to submission of the application packet.
  - The boxes on the coversheet are designed to automatically expand when text is entered.
- ✓ Applicants will be evaluated based upon this application packet and their CSU transcript. Student applications will be reviewed by staff in the Honors College.
- ✓ A list of eligible students will be made available to LRI faculty, who will choose students based on their own criteria and interests.
- ✓ An interview and lab practical may be required.

## **Anticipated Timeline:**

Application Packets due to Honors Program Office: October 31, 2022

Recommendations by the Honors Program to LRI: November 7, 2022

Decisions by LRI faculty: mid December 2022

Student work begins at LRI: January 2023

**Note:** LRI can accommodate only a small number of undergraduate students, so there is no guarantee that a student recommended by CSU will be accepted for this experience.
