The Downtown Review is an open-access, interdisciplinary journal maintained by the Cleveland State University Mandel Honors College. Accepted papers will be published and available for academic audiences globally from the journal's homepage. There have been more than 100,000 article downloads since the journal's launch in 2015. So, if you want your ideas to reach a global audience, or if you just want publication practice in a low-stress and supportive environment, then you will definitely want to consider submitting to *The Downtown Review*.

## **Guidelines**

The Downtown Review is seeking submissions that meet the following criteria:

- 1) Are the work of present Honors or Scholars students;
- 2) Are original and of high quality, yet accessible to a general audience;
- 3) And were written/created for undergraduate courses at Cleveland State University (<u>any</u> discipline welcome, including arts and sciences).

## **Submissions**

Papers must be submitted via *The Downtown Review*'s platform at https://engagedscholarship.c-suohio.edu/tdr/. The author will need to create a free account. All editor communications (including acceptances, rejections, requests for revisions, and publication notices) will be forwarded to the author's provided email address, and all revisions and future submissions must also be submitted through the platform. Note: *Submission to the journal does not guarantee acceptance or publication*. You can read more about publication policies on the journal's website.

## **Process**

All submissions will undergo a double-blind review process. Each paper will be assigned to three student reviewers from the Academic Journal Editing sections of HON 200(1): two reviewers from the paper's broad discipline (science, social science, or arts and humanities) and one from outside that discipline. Reviewers will choose whether the paper should be accepted and/or provide recommendations for revisions before acceptance and publication. Divided recommendations will be decided by a simple majority.
