CHEMISTRY DEPARTMENT

The Chemistry Department participates in the [Scholars Program](#) at CSU by requiring scholar students who are chemistry majors (available for all tracks) to register for research courses (either [CHM 379H Independent Study](#) or, with senior status, [CHM 489H Senior Research](#)) under the guidance of a professor who acts as mentor. Scholars chemistry students are required to enroll in at least 2 credit hours of research coursework each semester, for a minimum of 8 credit hours by the time of degree completion. Students are required to begin enrolling in research courses upon declaration of a Chemistry major or upon acceptance into the Honors Program. By getting involved in scientific research as soon as possible, scholars students will better understand chemistry's status as a bench science and have the opportunity to participate in original, ground-breaking laboratory work
